



Shutter Fold Book and Labels

1. Fold a piece of paper in half, hamburger style.
2. Fold the paper again, in the same direction, so that you create a four column paper.
3. Open the paper so that it is flat. Bring the two outside edges to the center fold, creating a “shutter”.
4. Lay the paper long way, so that the flaps open to the top and bottom.
5. fold the paper again, edge to edge, and cut this fold on the flaps only.
6. Label one side of the paper, “Qualifications” and the other side “How to...”.
7. Cut the boxes out and glue under the correct side.
