Shutter Fold book:

1. Holding the paper horizontal, fold the paper so that you create 4 columns.
2. Keeping it folded, fold in half (top to bottom).
3. Open up paper and fold the two outside flaps to the middle crease.
4. Cut the middle fold on the two top flaps.
5. Cut out the pieces and match the descriptions to the explanations.
6. Glue the main idea on the outside (top) and the explanation under the correct flap.
7. If you have room, cut out the box above and glue to the outside of the book, cutting where necessary to make sure the book opens.
8. Glue into notebook for review.
