

EGYPT AND CHINA FOLDABLE

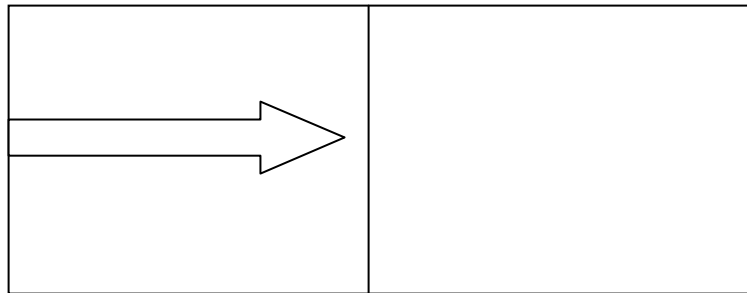
Materials Needed:

- 11"x17" paper or larger for each student
- 8 ½ " x 11" [world map](#) for each student

First Activity:

On the world map, have students label continents, oceans, create a compass rose and then color or circle Egypt and China. (Doing this before gluing will make the activity easier, as to not draw or color on glued paper.)

1. Holding the paper horizontally (long way) fold in half, and then in half again, creating 4 columns.



2. Unfold paper and fold two side flaps to the center, creating a "shutter" effect.
3. Rotate paper so that the flaps open to the top and bottom.
4. Open the flaps and glue the world map to the center two sections.
5. Fold flaps so that the map is covered. Label on flap Egypt and the other China. Be sure to allow room for students to illustrate concepts from each civilization. Or, use the labels provided at the end of directions.
6. On the front flaps, have students write the type of environment, location and the architecture of each civilization. Students will then illustrate the concepts. (Pyramids and Great Wall of China, for example).
7. On the inside of the flaps, write and illustrate the inventions, contributions and writing types, once again leaving room for illustrations.
8. Hand a few on a bulletin board, or have students put into notebook.
