All teachers, building administrators, Supervisors, Coordinators, and Directors are invited to register for workshops at TEACH Academy.

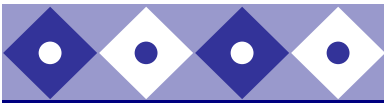
Venue. TEACH Academy will be held at Woodrow Wilson High School, located at 1401 Elmhurst Lane, Portsmouth, VA 23701. Classrooms in the business wing will be used for TEACH Academy during this time.

Food. The daily lunch break will be from 11:30 - 1:00. Participants will be responsible for their own lunch arrangements. Cafeteria services will NOT be available during TEACH Academy. Maps will be provided at registration/check in detailing where local eateries can be found. Snacks and cold drinks will be available at the concession in the foyer. The concession stand will be operated by the Portsmouth Education Association.

Presentation types. All Sessions will be hands-on experiential type sessions. All sessions will take place in computer labs. At the close of each session, participants will be required to submit the resource they have created to the TRT who is assisting the presenter. After the resources have been collected, each participant will receive a stamp on their TEACH Academy "progress report".

Professional Development Points. At the conclusion of TEACH Academy, participants may exchange their "progress reports" for a certificate which will state the number of professional development points earned for their participation in TEACH Academy. One point will be earned for every hour a participant is in attendance if they hand in the resource created during each session. Participants must be on time and stay for the entire workshop to receive any professional development points. Points are given all or nothing. Participants who arrive late, return late from lunch, or leave early will receive no professional development points.

Session Evaluation. Participants will be asked to evaluate each session. Session evaluations will be collected electronically via the PPS online survey system.
